- ◆ **Lessons learned are shared among all DOE sites**
- ◆ **LL sources: DOE sites, HQ, GIDEP, etc.**





# What Is Important?

**Submit Lessons Learned to the DOE Corporate Lessons-Learned Database at:**

**Report the following types of items:**

- ◆ **Personal protective equipment**
- ◆ **Detection and monitoring equipment**
- ◆ **Safety-significant systems, e.g. fire safety, etc.**
- ◆ **Notifications of product defects/recalls**





# Importance of Lessons Learned

## Timely reporting of lessons learned is important

- ◆ **Site-submitted Lessons learned provides notification to the complex through corporate LL database**
- ◆ **Identified items may result in issuance of safety alerts or safety bulletins for serious issues – requiring follow-up**
- ◆ **DOE corporate LL database provides DOE's input to GIDEP**
