THE BIOLOGICAL RESURVEY OF BIKINI AND SURVEY OF ENTREROK ATOLLS

BACKGROUND

I wish to inform you that Dr. Charles E. Donaldson, Director of the Applied Fisheries Laboratory, University of Washington, Seattle, has completed the biological resurvey of Bikini and survey of Eniwetok Atolls concerning which the Commission was informed by Info-Note 46-90 dated July 13, 1948.

The expedition of Commander Charles E. Marshall, USA, in command of the U.S.A.T. "Dewey" and his crew, was carried out under a contract with the Sanford Directed Operations Office with general direction coming from the Washington Office of the Division of Biology and Medicine. The Navy Department provided forward area support including the assignment of a Naval officer in a liaison capacity accompanying the expedition, and surface craft, transportation, housing and other assistance. The Navy Department has been advised of the satisfactory completion of the expedition and their assistance has been acknowledged. (See Appendix "A").

3. A preliminary report from Dr. Donaldson is attached as Appendix "B". Dr. J. H. Jensen, Chief, of the Biology Branch of the Division of Biology and Medicine will review and assist in directing the follow-up laboratory work into areas of most interest to the Commission.
