MEMO ON PRESENT STATUS OF ARRANGEMENTS ON DONALDSON EXPEDITION

1. Security Clearance: Will request teletype confirmation that all men have clearance. (Koch given Special Clearance by arrangements between Shugg and Gingrich.) Navy and State will then be notified.
2. We advised men to report to Navy Commands for I.D. Cards, and Navy advised Commandants to expect them.
3. Navy has initiated action on Military Orders: Hanford, on AEC Travel Orders.
4. Permission to use I.D. Cards in lieu of Passports has been requested of State Department. (other required notification papers in process)
5. Navy has assigned Lt. (j.g.) Schmidt (USN) as Liaison Officer to accompany Donaldson. He will be in Washington to be briefed by Capt. Russell and Division of Biology and Medicine — Then will meet Donaldson in Seattle.
6. Hanford is making arrangements for "CARCO" at Los Alamos to provide transportation of group to Alameda or Moffett Field on June 26th. Navy making travel arrangements beyond.
7. Navy has made arrangements for expedition to spend one week at Eniwetok.
8. \$20,000 additional transferred to Navy from Washington Office (Division of Biology and Medicine Funds)
