I hope that the Milicbi can be made available to take the team between Kwajalein and Rongelap. Perhaps the ship could be used for routine field trip operations during our 6-7 day stay at Rongelap.

It will be appreciated if the following Trust Territory personnel (medical) can participate:

A practitioner for taking medical histories and to act as interpreter; Sebco Shoniber and Nelson Zettiker to act as laboratory technicians; and Mr. Ernest Libby to take X rays and carry out medical photography.

Drs. Brown Dobyns and Leo Meyer and Knud Knudsen will participate, in addition to Bill Scott, Doug Claeus and Mike Makar.

We have hopes that the AEC in Honolulu will be able to make available the trailer (such as we have at Ebeye and Rongelap) for our use at Majuro. This would avoid the interference of our examinations with the hospital routine there. Ms. William Hillis, Director of the AEC in Honolulu, who will visit Kwajalein soon, will make the contact Oscar DeBrum about this and about the possibility of lessening the trailer near the hospital. I hope this goes with your approval and also the approval of Drs. Kumanzai and Ianson.

I am taking the liberty of sending copies of this letter to various Trust Territory personnel who may be involved in the survey.
