SUBJECT RONGELAP/UTIRIK CITIZENS MEETING AT EBEYE WIDOE  
RONGELAP AND UTERIL PEOPLE LIVING ON EBEYE HAD BEEN ASKING DR. HUGH PRATT, ONL, MANY QUESTIONS THIS PAST WEEK CONCERNING DOE POLICY AND THE LACK OF PAYMENTS OF PER DIEM UNDER TTPI PL-5-52. DR. PRATT FELT THAT A DOE REPRESENTATIVE SHOULD ADDRESS THESE ISSUES AND AFTER CHECKING WITH ME, SET UP A MEETING IN WHICH HE, SCOTT STEGE, TTPI LNO, KWAJALEIN AND I PARTICIPATED. MEETING ON EBEYE JANUARY 29 WAS HELD IN THE HOSPITAL AND LASTED FROM 7 PM UNTIL ALMOST MIDNIGHT. QUESTIONS AND PROBLEMS GENERALLY WERE DIRECTED AT WHY PER DIEM PAYMENTS NOT MADE TO MANY PEOPLE, WHY CERTAIN CLAIMS FOR COMPENSATION FOR PEOPLE WITH THYROID ABNORMALITIES AND FOR OTHERS FROM RONGELAP AND UTIRIK WHO ARE HEIRS OF DECEASED PERSONS HAVE NOT RECEIVED PAYMENT UNDER THE RECENT US COMPENSATION ACT; AND OTHER GENERAL QUESTIONS SURROUNDING TTPI PL'S 5-52, 7-116 AND DOE/TTPI AGREEMENTS. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO MY TRIP REPORT. ONE QUESTION CONCERNED A PERSON WHO LIVES ON EBEYE BUT EATS FOOD FROM HIS HOMELAND (RONGELAP) WHICH IS REGULARLY SENT TO HIM. HE WANTED TO KNOW IF HE WAS BEING HARMED. THIS PROVIDED AN ENTREE TO EXPLAIN THAT THE RECENT RADIOLOGICAL SURVEY, WHICH WAS THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE OF ITS KIND TO MY KNOWLEDGE, WOULD PROVIDE INFORMATION WHICH WOULD ANSWER THESE KINDS OF QUESTIONS.
