 RETURN TO KVAJALEIN. THE LCU SHOULD HAVE THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT ON
 BOARD:

IT IS PLANNED THAT DR. R. CONARD, N. GREENHOUSE AND V. MEINHOLD OF
 BNL, AND STREEMAN OF AEC WILL PROCEED VIA MAC TO ENEWETAK FROM
 HONOLULU ON DECEMBER 4. IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE ARMY C-54 BE MADE
 AVAILABLE UNDER A CHARTER BASIS TO THE AEC AND FLY TO ENEWETAK ON
 DECEMBER 8 AND PICK UP THESE FOUR ABOVE LISTED PEOPLE AND FOUR
 PERSONNEL FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, AND PROCEED TO BIKINI WHERE
 GREENHOUSE, MEINHOLD AND THE FOUR UNIVERISYI OF HAWAII PERSONNEL WILL
