For your information and guidance the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission has NOT issued any information recently on activities or organizations related to the Pacific Proving Grounds.

The last official public statement on this subject was issued in the 14th semiannual report and prior to that expansion of the PPG was announced on April 2, 1953 (Release No. 478). No information beyond these official statements is approved for issuance.

There should be no comment by AEC or contractor personnel on news stories speculating on time or type of tests.
