SUBJ: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN DEPLOYED MEDICAL ELEMENTS/UNITS

DIRECTOR OF BASE MEDICAL SERVICE (DBMS)

The managerial role of the DBMS is stated in AFM 130-4, para 1-5a. All medical pers, assigned or attached, required to carry out the mission of the base medical services are under the professional supervision of the DBMS. It must be clear to all DBMS, in exercising this responsibility, that it is cognizant that the primary mission of an air transportable clinic/squadron medical element is to provide aeromedical support to its parent squadron. Med pers deploying to another base during exercise are expected to report to the local DBMS upon arrival and establish a cooperative working relationship with regard to SPT of both the flying unit to which they are assigned and other assigned/attached base personnel.


