

SUBJECT: Sanatation and Veterinary Inspection of Japtan

1. The island of Japtan was visited on 17 Dec 79 by Dr. Powell and MSgt Moore. One patient was seen with a fractured ankle, and was advised that the cast could be removed later this week. Another patient's eye was examined and his bl~~e~~pharitis was found to be resolving, so present treatment should be continued.
2. The medic at Japtan, Joe Saul, was informed that the clinic at Fnewetak, would be more than happy to assist him with definitive therapy that might be required for all patients.
3. A veterinary inspection was performed and no major problem areas were identified. Food-stuffs were examined and no evidence of contamination is likely. Outhouses were inspected and found to be adequate.
4. It should be noted that these periodic visits to Japtan are beneficial to the Marshallese populace medically and environmentally to establish better living condition.
