We are in receipt of a letter from the Field Manager, AEC, reference PG-2-1528, dated January 30, 1953, which states:

"Receipt is acknowledged of your cost estimate in the amount of \$41,005 and drawing No. 5201-EE-2 for infiltration lines, Building #347.

"Due to limited funds remaining in FY 1953 for this type of work, approval cannot be granted at this time. It is suggested that this plan be thoroughly reviewed to ascertain if there is a cheaper satisfactory method of accomplishing this work. The subject drawing is being sent to Mr. H. H. Lewis for jobsite comments."

As you will recall, the estimate and drawing for this work was submitted to the Field Manager by the Los Angeles office under Engineering Change Order No. 3737. A copy of the detailed estimate was forwarded to you at the jobsite.

In view of the above action by the Field Manager, I have discussed this matter with D. L. Harver, Jr., and he has indicated that he will forward to you a print of Drawing 5201-EE-2, together with his recommendation relative to installing a portion of this infiltration line at the present time and not installing the total length of infiltration line until such time as it is necessary for CMR operations.

I would suggest that when jobsite determines a less expensive method of doing this work that the estimate of cost be submitted to the home office as an Original Cost Estimate supplemental to the estimate submitted by the home office on January 27, 1953 for Engineering Change Order No. 3737.
