Dear Sir:

Reference is made to CJTF SEVEN letter file J-3/000.93 of 17 January 1956 and your letter O-4 of 23 March 1956.

CJTF SEVEN is currently studying weather observation requirements for Operation HANDTACK. It has been determined that weather observations furnished by the U. S. Weather Bureau during REDWIND from stations at YAP, POGAPE, TRUK, WAKE, KOSOR, and MAJURO will be needed during HANDTACK.

CJTF SEVEN proposes to fund for the construction by the contractor during FY 58 involving two weather stations located on TRUK and MAJURO Islands. Each station will be essentially identical to the MAJURO station. The structure will be of wood frame construction with concrete floor slabs, plywood siding, aluminum roofing, with roll-up door in the high section of the building, and interior walls and ceiling lined with painted plywood as shown on H&N drawing 53009-1Q1 (revised). Location of the buildings will be coordinated with weather bureau personnel at these sites. Your comments and concurrence relative to the above proposal is requested.
