Subject: Sandspits for Project 1.2b

Dear Sir:

As per your letter J-17989 dated May 12, 1953, we are forwarding the following information with regard to Item 5 which we have received from the Job Site.

The largest sandspit west of Site No. 1 has a plus 7.0 contour approximately 650 feet long by 50 feet wide. The highest point found was plus 6.1. The long axis of the spit has a bearing of North 75 degrees East. The coordinates of approximate center of excess are N166, 190 S11, 265.

The coordinates are based on the Preliminary Plant Grid system and development was made on the site top traverse shown on Field Sketch 1015, Revision one.
