I am attaching marked-up folder title listings of former Oak Ridge records collections which are now in the custody of the National Archives and Records Administration in Atlanta, Georgia. I am providing them so that you may forward them to the Marshallese. I was asked to do this at our meeting at the Marshallese Embassy on December 16.

Attached are listings of the Oak Ridge Research Division collection, of the Oak Ridge Division of Research and Medicine collection, and of the Oak Ridge Division of Research and Development collection. I have highlighted those folders in each which I think might contain information falling within the scope of document search for the Marshall Islands Government. Because every researcher approaches records collections from a different perspective, the folders highlighted are not presented as all those which may contain pertinent information. They are merely those which seem as obvious candidates from a reading of the finding aids on which they appear.

For completeness I am also attaching a listing of the Manhattan Engineer District Central Files records collection, which is also stored in Atlanta. I have found no folders in it which appear to contain information which falls under the scope of document search. I thought, however, that the Marshallese might want a copy.

I have also attached the appropriate records series description to each folder title listing.
