


NMMSS Users Annual Training Meeting 2006

Overview

The NMMSS Users Annual Training Meeting 2006 will be held May 23-25 at the Caribe Royale, 8101 World Center Drive, Orlando, Florida. The theme for this year's meeting is 30 Years of Service. The training meeting's general sessions will focus on:

- ◆ The needs and usage of NMMSS information by the government, other countries, and the IAEA
- ◆ NMMSS upgrade progress and impacts
- ◆ Data quality improvements
- ◆ Obligations tracking
- ◆ Planned changes to DOE and NRC NMMSS reporting instructions
- ◆ Yucca Mountain handling of spent fuel

There will also be break-out training sessions for the DOE contractors and NRC licensees to discuss issues and topics of specific interest and opportunities for break-out training sessions to discuss issues and topics of special interest. The NRC session will cover such areas as decommissioning, reporting, reactor inspections, and the usage of MOX fuel. The DOE session will examine item-level accounting, reconciliation, report distribution, project numbers, and quality panel results.

In addition to the general and break-out training sessions, two other training sessions will be provided. A training session on the revised SAMS will be conducted for new and experienced users and for new users, an introductory NMMSS training module will be provided.
